Fruit is picked at dawn & trucked back to Zorgvliet winery for 100% wild yeast fermentation, then a portion goes into 6 months barrel ageing. Pecorino, IGT Colline Pescaresi <i>Italy 2017</i> One of Italy's most interesting & increasingly fashionable varieties! The Stump Jump white blend, d'Arenberg <i>Australia 2017</i> Riesling gives the finesse & class to this wine, Sauvignon blanc adds loads of aromatics, & the Marsanne & Roussanne provide complexity, weight & nuttiness to the palate. Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio <i>Italy 2016</i> Gavi has been dubbed the "Chablis of Italy", due to it's fresh, steely minerality. Viognier Roussanne, Sutherland <i>South Africa 2014</i> Made by the winemaker of the acclaimed Thelema Mountain Vineyards, this stunning blend offers sun-dried apricot, marzipan & rose petal aromas, with rosemary undertones. This wine is big with some prominent, toasty notes among the fruit. The finish is clean, fresh & minerally & very long.				34.50
Chablis, Domaine Bernard Defaix <i>Burgundy, France 2017</i> Chablis is famous for its dry, minerally Chardonnay. The limestone soils of Chablis allow for the production of truly world class wines of which this is no exception. Sancerre Grande Cuvee J.P Ballard <i>Loire, France 2014</i> Most Sancerre should be enjoyed young & fresh; but a handful of growers believe that more complex, rich wines are possible. Jean-Paul Ballard makes one of Sancerre's greatest whites. 2/3 15 months in large oak barrels, 1/3 stainless steel. The fruit is beautifully integrated & is of the ripe grapefruit sort & blends harmoniously with the slight spicy flavours of the oak.				48
The FMC, Chenin, Ken Forrester Wines <i>South Africa 2016</i> Winemaker Ken Forrester is known as 'Mr Chenin' & wines such as The FMC have elevated South African Chenin to classic status. Can you guess what FMC stands for?!				55

Land Made Pinot Noir, Yealands <i>New Zealand 2016</i> The region may be best known for it's Sauvignon Blanc but the Pinot Noir grape truly reflects the islands soul. Charming, approachable yet refined, where juicy ripe red fruit flavours lead into a supple, soft tannin finish.				32.95
Hollicks Stock Route, Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Australia 2012</i> Taking its name from the Stock Route which ran along the higher ridges between Coonawarra & Wrattobully. By far, the most popular grape in Australia is Shiraz. With its lush, dark fruit, earth, & spice flavours that it's known for. When combined with Cab Sauv to add muscle & complexity it makes the perfect pairing. A rich bull bodied example with 18 months in French oak.				33.95
Rioja Reserva, Ramón Bilbao <i>Spain 2012</i> Reserva Rioja requires a minimum of 3 years total ageing in cask & bottle before release, resulting in a sumptuous & classical wine with notes of blackberries, cedar, leather & spices. Good balance on the palate with a long finish.				39.95
Château Bertinat Lartigue, Saint Emilion <i>Bordeaux, France 2013</i> Just half an hour away from the city of Bordeaux is beautiful St Emilion where wines are made predominantly from the Merlot grape. This has such enticing aromas of ripe plums, blackberries & a hint of herbs. Swirl the glass & classic nuances of cedar emerge. Take a sip, and it's silky-smooth, with beautiful texture to the tannins.				44
Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda <i>Italy 2014</i> The current holders of Wine Spectator's "European Winery of the Year" Fontanafredda has made this superb, complex, velvety, well balanced Barolo made from the Nebbiolo grape variety.				57
Châteauneuf du Pape Tradition, Domaine de la Janasse <i>Rhone, France 2013</i> Domaine de la Janasse, is undoubtedly one of the finest states in the Rhône. Fruit-driven aromas of cassis, redcurrant, smoke, spice & animal fur. Soft, lush & ripe, with enticing fruit & good balance. Easy going, generous & balanced for early drinking appeal.				60



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
