<b>Château Bertinat Lartigue, Saint Emilion</b> <i>Bordeaux, France 2014</i>							47
Just half an hour away from the city of Bordeaux is beautiful St Emilion where wines are made predominantly from the Merlot grape. This has such enticing aromas of ripe plums, blackberries & a hint of herbs. Swirl the glass & classic nuances of cedar emerge. Take a sip, and it's silky-smooth, with beautiful texture to the tannins.
